Notes on grants

1. Section 134 of the Environmental Protection Act 1990, English Nature to give grant to others for "...doing anything which, in their opinion, is conducive to nature conservation, or fostering the understanding of nature conservation".
2. Applicants are recommended to familiarise themselves with the current editions of our grant information leaflets.
3. The grant recipient will ensure that, in carrying out the grant activity, it and anyone acting on its behalf, complies with the law for the time being in force in the United Kingdom and, in particular, does not commit any act of discrimination rendered unlawful by the Sex Discrimination Act 1975 or Race Relations Act 1976.
4. Grants may be awarded to individuals or to organisations, private or public. Our officers will be pleased to advise and assist prospective applicants but this help should be sought at an early stage in the formulation of projects.
5. Projects will be grant-aided according to their expected direct benefits to nature conservation. Preference will be given to new and imaginative projects. We will not accept any obligation to continue support or contribute to further costs.
6. Where a grant is sought to manage a site of nature conservation importance, the applicant's interest in the land must be sufficient to justify expenditure from public funds.
7. Where a project is concerned with the provision of interpretative facilities such as visitor centres or nature trails, we will need to be satisfied that there is adequate public access.
8. There is no automatic entitlement to grant.
9. In making any offer of grant we may impose such conditions as we think fit, including repayment in specified circumstances.
10. No grant will be paid where a project is started prior to our offer being made to the applicant.
11. Grants are intended to be contributions only towards costs. Payment is normally made in arrears against receipts during the financial year in which a project is completed. In some circumstances payment may be by instalments, especially where projects start in one financial year and finish in another.
